Our Commitment to Net Zero

Savorah Care Limited, established in 2026, is committed to reducing our environmental impact and achieving Net Zero carbon emissions by 2050, in line with UK and Welsh Government targets.

As a domiciliary care provider, we recognise that our operations particularly staff travel and service delivery contribute to carbon emissions. We are committed to reducing these emissions and working collaboratively with commissioners, suppliers, and stakeholders to support wider environmental objectives.

Our Current Approach

Since our establishment in 2026, Savorah Care Limited has embedded sustainable practices across the organisation from the outset, ensuring environmentally responsible operations alongside high-quality care delivery.

Key improvements include:

- Implementation of a fully digital care management system using Huddle Care (huddlecare.co.uk), eliminating the need for paper-based care records
- Use of advanced, state-of-the-art routing and scheduling software to optimise care runs, reduce travel time, and minimise fuel usage
- Fully paperless systems across care delivery, compliance, and administration
- Efficient coordination of care services to reduce unnecessary travel and improve operational efficiency

We have already implemented a number of practical and measurable initiatives to reduce our carbon footprint across our services:

Sustainable Travel

- Use of advanced routing software to optimise travel routes and reduce mileage
- Reduction in unnecessary journeys through efficient scheduling and coordination
- Promotion of localised care runs to minimise travel distances

Digital & Paperless Systems

- Full implementation of Huddle Care as the primary care management system
- Elimination of paper-based care plans, MAR charts, and daily records
- Digital communication, monitoring, and reporting across all operations
- Reduced environmental impact through minimised paper usage



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Operational Efficiency Gains

- Implementation of Huddle Care has improved accuracy, reduced duplication, and enhanced real-time monitoring of care delivery
- Use of modern routing technology has significantly reduced travel time and fuel consumption
- Fully integrated digital systems have streamlined compliance, reporting, and operational processes

These improvements have supported a fully paperless operating model and contributed to a reduction in indirect carbon emissions associated with both travel and administrative processes.

Emissions Measurement Notes

Estimated emissions reductions have been supported by:

- Improved rota planning and advanced route optimisation software
- Transition to fully digital care systems via Huddle Care
- Elimination of routine paper-based documentation
- More efficient coordination of care delivery and staff travel

- Achieving a 50% reduction in carbon emissions by 2030
- Continuous annual reductions in emissions
- Achieving Net Zero by 2050

Future Commitments

To further reduce our environmental impact and strengthen our sustainability approach, Savorah Care Limited is committed to the following:

- **Expanding the use of advanced routing technology** to further optimise care schedules, reduce travel distances, and minimise fuel consumption
- **Maximising the use of digital systems**, including continued development of **Huddle Care**, to maintain a fully paperless and efficient service
- **Exploring low-emission travel options**, including encouraging the use of walking routes, cycling, and other sustainable transport methods where appropriate
- **Improving data collection and carbon reporting**, with a focus on accurately measuring Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions in line with WPPN 06/21 requirements



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- **Working with suppliers and partners** to support environmentally responsible procurement and reduce supply chain emissions
- **Increasing staff awareness and training** around sustainability, promoting environmentally responsible practices across all roles
- **Regularly reviewing operational practices** to identify further opportunities for carbon reduction and efficiency improvements
- **Maintaining strong governance and leadership oversight**, ensuring sustainability remains embedded within service delivery and organisational culture

Monitoring and Governance

Responsibility for this plan sits with senior management and the Responsible Individual.

We will:

- Review progress annually
- Update this plan in line with WPPN 06/21 requirements
- Work with commissioning bodies to support Scope 3 emissions reduction
